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1. Summary:

WetterWelt MeteoPILOT 4 is designed as an onboard weather routing software – as well as a fleet management tool for route planning and tracking different voyages simultaneously.

It provides a route management tool, easy to handle weather data requests and extensive display function with integration of weather and voyage planning/tracking data. ETA- and cost-calculations based on individual speed and consumption profiles of a vessel can be achieved with only a few clicks.

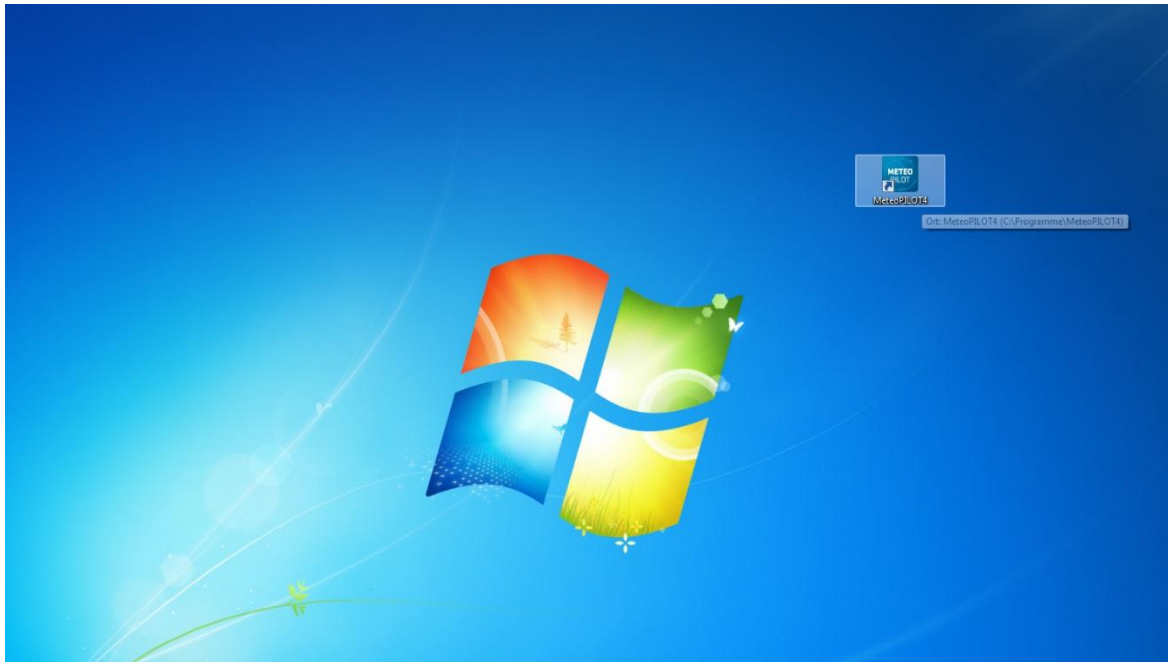
WetterWelt MeteoPILOT 4 DEMO is free of charge available via **<https://shipping.wetterwelt.de/downloads>**

The program requires at least a screen resolution of 1024x768, 500 MB free disk space and at least a Windows 7 64bit-system.

For 32bit systems, a version 4.5 x86 is still available.

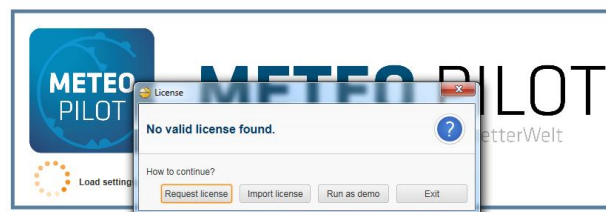
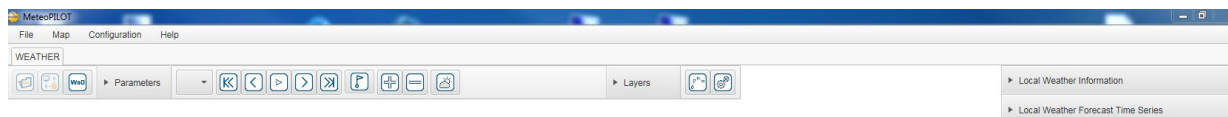
The performance of the program can be improved, when the max.RAM allocated by the program is adjusted manually. If required, then please contact your system administrator / WetterWelt.

2. First Start – DEMO Mode, License Request:



After successful installation double-click MP4-button and start the program.

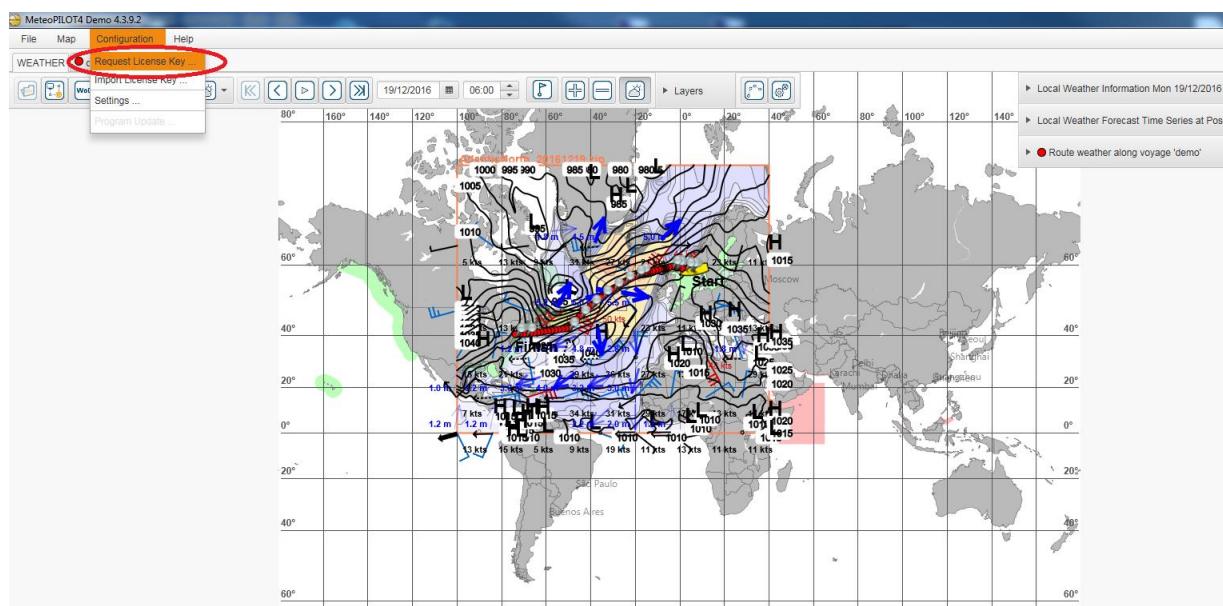
Decide, whether to start the program in DEMO-mode or to set up a license request.



→ Run as DEMO:

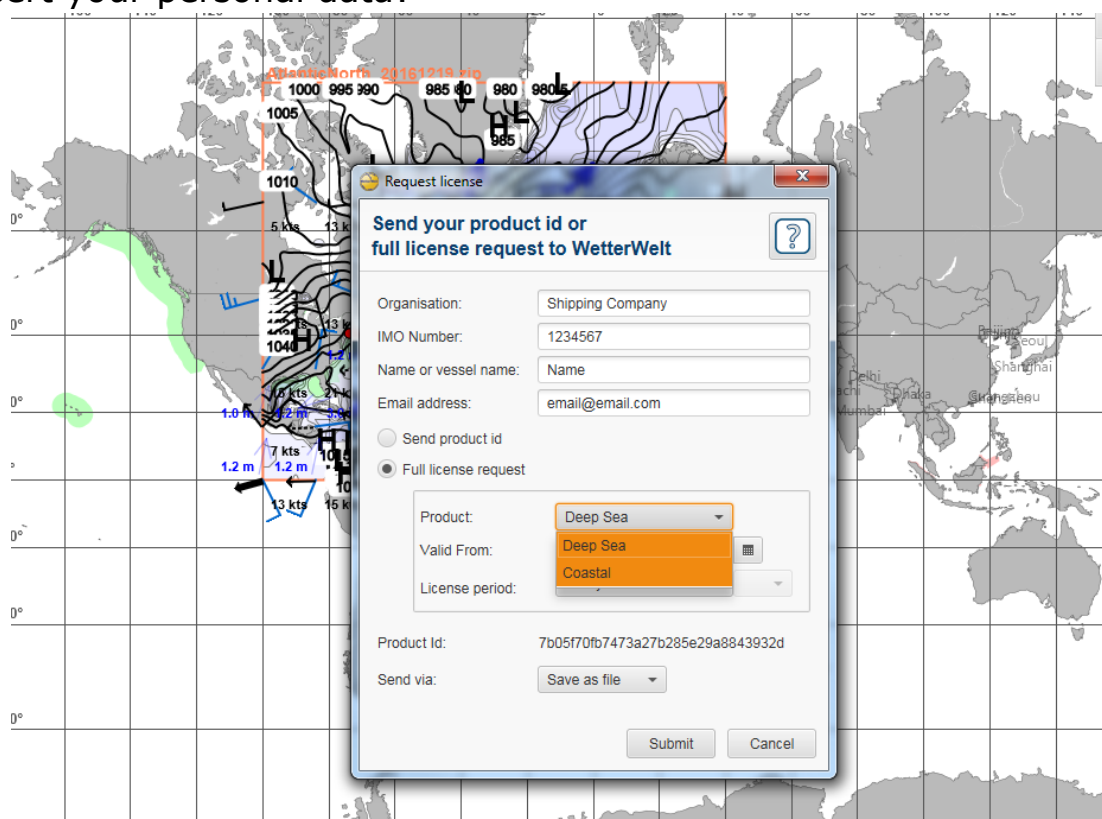
Program starts in DEMO-Mode.

→ REQUEST a License:



Go to: → Configuration → Request License Key

Insert your personal data:



Choose option 'Full license request' → you want a single, individual license for MP4 (Are the licensing details in your request required or are there agreements with your company?)



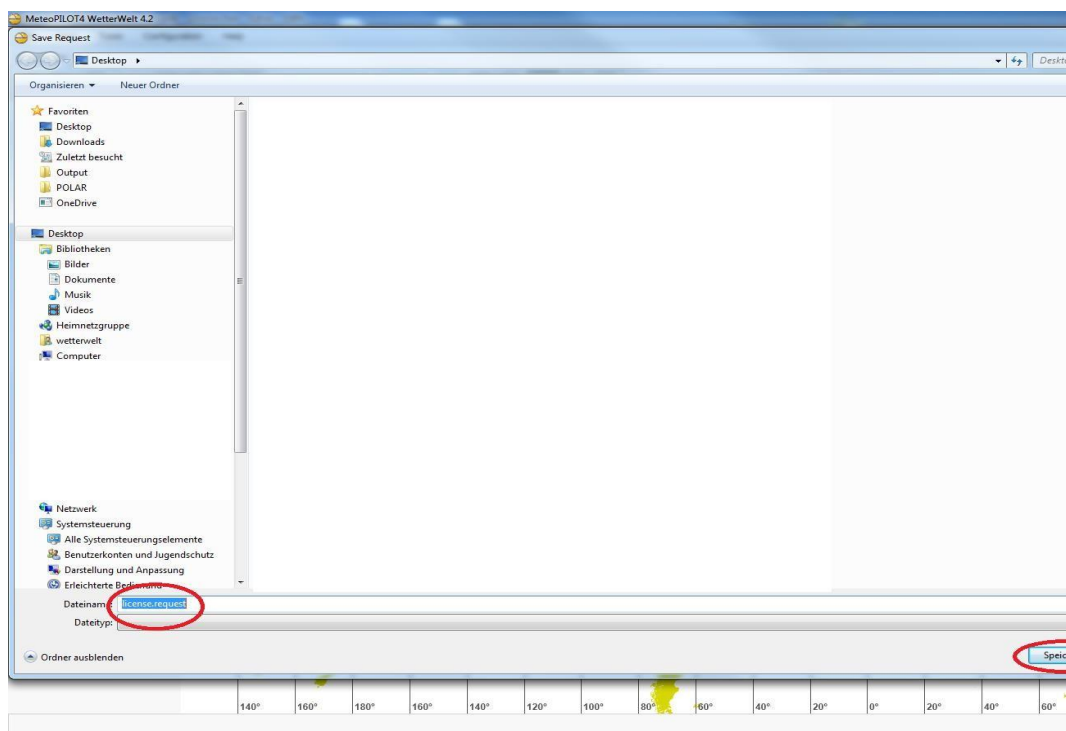
Choose whether you want a license for the 'Deep Sea' or the 'Coastal' version in the drop down menu and define the start and duration of your license.

There are two Options for sending the license.request file:

(A) Via 'save as file' to send request as email attachment:

Choose 'Save as file' → press "Submit"

→ Save license request file on your local drive.



Open an email and attach this file. Send the email to:

routing@wetterwelt.de

(B) Submit request directly via internet:

Choose 'Internet' → press "Submit"

The program will directly send the request to WetterWelt (requires internet connection)

With both options WetterWelt receives your request and gets in contact with you / your office within 24 hours.

After clarifying the license details and the accounting details, WetterWelt sends your license file as attachment via email.

Please note:

Each customer license allows a maximum of 3 PC-installations, but you need to send a license request for each installation.

Each installation creates its own Product-ID. They are stored customer-related and managed from WetterWelt

For each Installation / Product-ID you will receive your license file.

3. Import License-file into MP4:

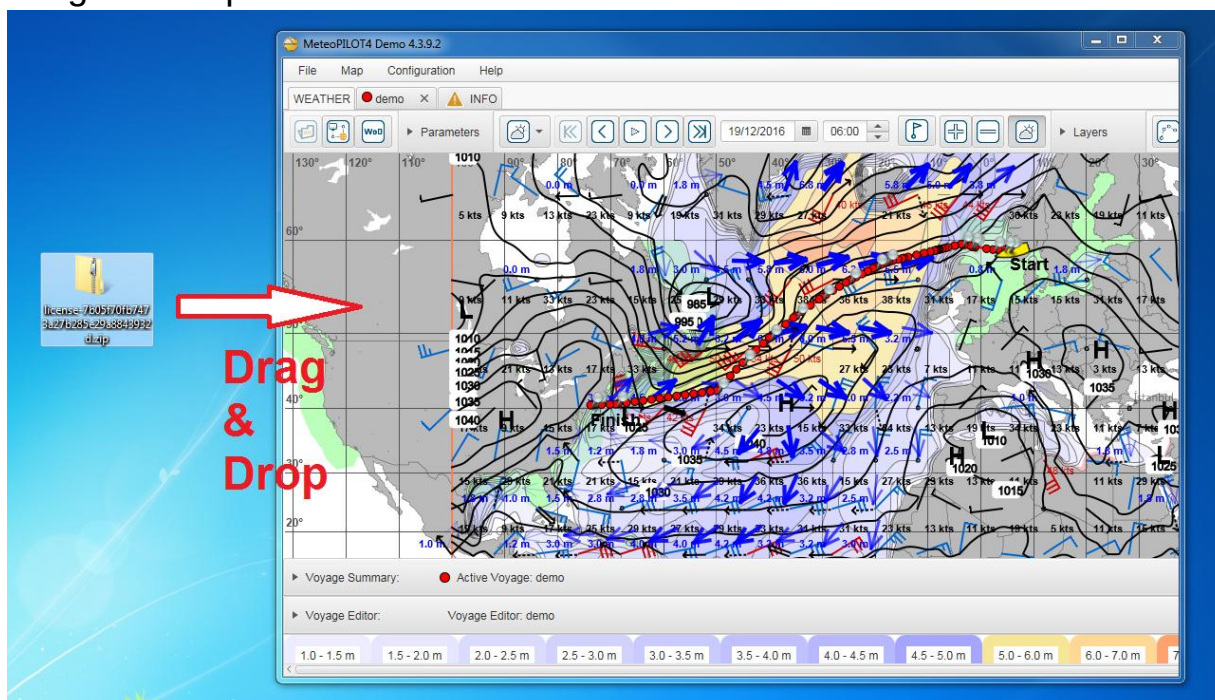
The license-file will be provided to you as an email attachment with the name: 'license-<Product-ID>.zip'

→ save this .zip-file on your computer and import the license file.

There are two ways to import the license-file:

(A) Drag and drop

Drag and drop the file into the weather screen.



(B) Via main menu:

Go to: → Configuration → Import license key

With the full version you now have access to:

- load / download current weather forecast files
- use route planning and cost calculation tool
- import / export speed and consumption profiles
- manage different voyages at the same time (fleet monitoring)
- access to climate data



4. Get Information about Imported Licenses:

The full version of MeteoPILOT 4 runs in the following modes:
(according to requested program mode)

(1) COASTAL, (2) DEEP SEA and (3) SKYPM

Your program mode is shown in the upper left header line.

If you want to see further details of your license:

Go to: → main menu → Help → About

The table shows all licenses that have been imported into your MeteoPILOT 4 and the ones that have not been deleted so far.

The valid license is shown in orange.

You can delete all licenses using the delete button.

Old licenses can be deleted without any further program action.

If you delete all valid licenses, the program switches back to DEMO mode.

If you have different licenses for different modes (DEEP SEA or COASTAL), the program switches to the mode of the newest license.

New licenses can be requested from WetterWelt at any time.

Integrated in the license are the following settings:

- max. subscription number (i.e. weather subscriptions at the same time)
- max. request number (i.e. single weather data requests per day)

HOW TO request and import licenses into MP4

- max. file size (i.e. max. estimated size of the requested weather data; weather files greater than max. file size cannot be requested).
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Attention:

With each licensing in Coastal or DeepSea, you can run the MeteoPILOT 4 on max. **three** workstations. For each workstation you need to submit an individual license request and import the associated license file.
